- Character

- Completed application

How to apply:

- Complete the application (typed or handwritten)
- Mail or hand deliver a copy of the application and writing sample to the front office at Charlotte Preparatory School. It is advisable to call the front office to ensure the mailed copy has been received.

What happens once we receive your application:

- A committee will assess your application
- If selected, you will be invited to attend the graduation ceremony on May 23rd at 6:00 PM. We kindly ask that you arrive by 5:45 PM, at which time your name will be announced. You will be free to depart following the conclusion of the ceremony. Additionally, you are welcome to invite your family, who may sit with you in the designated seating area of the event.
- Winners will be responsible to show proof of acceptance at a post-secondary institution before payment will be given.
